

## CODE E6

### ***EMERGENCY CLOSINGS***

The superintendent or designee may order the closing of any and all schools whose operation on a short-term basis would pose a serious threat to students or staff and/or other members of the community.

#### **Implementation**

The superintendent or designee may close schools, delay opening, dismiss early or any other such action aimed at reducing a safety threat to students, staff and/or other members of the community for reasons and/or emergencies including but not limited to weather conditions, equipment breakdown, bomb threats, or health problems.

In all cases, notification will be given staff and the public according to a predetermined plan developed by the superintendent. When a school is closed for emergencies, the superintendent will notify the board chair of the impacted member district of Chittenden South Supervisory Union as soon as practicable.

Days lost due to emergency closings will be rescheduled so that school will be in session as required by state law.
